










LET'S TALK ABOUT MORE OPTIONS





VIRTUAL

Students can choose to take up to three virtual classes at a time through HVK12 or flvs.net

This is completed online at home.

OJT

This is an elective course for juniors and seniors who need to leave 1 - 2 periods early to go to work.

Students must already have a job.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

Up to ten college credits per semester are available to eligible high school students. Ask your school counselor for more information.

CREDIT RECOVERY

This takes the place of an elective.
Students will be in credit recovery if they failed a class.
