Dress Code and Grooming Standards

Dress code and grooming standards are expected on the first day of class, including orientation and clinicals.

- Black cargo pants (aka tactical pants). No jeans, leggings, or sweats.
- School-issued shirt with crew-neck undershirt (white, navy, or black).
 - Shirts will not be issued until after the first day of class. Students can wear any plain color collared shirt (polo) with an undershirt until they receive their school-issued shirts.
- Student ID badge clipped on right collar. We will take your picture and give you a student badge on the first day of class.
- Black work shoes or boots, clean and shined. (non-permeable, aka waterproof)
- Solid black or solid white socks. No “no-show” socks.
- Black belt
- Wristwatch (inexpensive and comfortable – digital OR analog watch). Digital watch must stay on for one minute.

Additional Requirements:

- The entire uniform must be clean and neat (iron as needed).
- Hair pulled back from face and off-collar. Hair **MUST** be a color naturally occurring in humans.
- No head coverings (ex: hats, bandanas, caps, scarves).
- Clean-shaven (NO FACIAL HAIR except eyebrows and eyelashes).
- Clean, short, unpolished natural fingernails.
- No fragrances or body odor (no body spray, cologne, perfume).
- No jewelry except a watch and a wedding ring.
- No visible piercings or tattoos.
