9th Grade

A student shall be eligible during the first semester of his/her ninth-grade year provided that, this is the student's first entry into the ninth grade, and he/she was regularly promoted from the eighth grade the immediately preceding year.

10th Grade

If you are in the 10th grade, you must have a cumulative 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 unweighted scale in all courses taken through the end of the previous semester.

11th & 12th Grade

If you are in the 11th grade or 12th grade, you must have a cumulative 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 unweighted scale (*State GPA*) in all courses taken through the end of the previous semester.

Limit of Eligibility

A student shall be eligible for no more than four (4) consecutive academic years upon first entrance to ninth grade as defined by the pupil progression plan of the school in which the student is enrolled.

Age

Students reaching the age of 19 before July 1st will be ineligible to participate in interscholastic athletics for that school year and beyond.

- Completed Stamped **Physical (4/24): pg.4 only!**
- Mandatory School Insurance
- FHSAA 3 required Videos
- Parent ID
- Current Proof of Residency (utility bill, etc.)
- Birth Certificate
- Enrollment History

4. Once everything is complete and *ALL* documents are uploaded, you will receive an email stating the student is cleared or denied for participation.
