Your school-aged children may have important rights you may not be aware of.

Have you heard of the McKinney-Vento Act?

The McKinney-Vento Act is a federal law which provides educational support for students who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence.

Have you recently experienced a loss of housing?

The definition of "homeless" includes the following living situations: living in a shelter, hotel, motel, vehicle, substandard housing, or doubled-up with friends or family due to a loss of housing or economic hardship.
