Preparing New Principals is a comprehensive, one-year program designed to cultivate a highly qualified and welltrained pool of instructional leaders prepared to fill principal positions in Hillsborough County Public Schools.

This **state-approved program** fulfills the requirements for Level II School Principal Certification, a required credential for serving as a principal in the state of Florida. Candidates must demonstrate excellence in the Florida Educational Leadership Standards (FELS) through an application, references, essays, evaluations, and successful performance in in-person interviews. This rigorous process ensures that only the most capable leaders advance to quide our schools effectively.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Master's degree or higher in Educational Leadership, Administration, or Administration and Supervision.
- At least one year of Effective (E) or Highly Effective (HE) evaluation rating as an Assistant Principal.
- Current or prior service as an Assistant Principal.
- Principal/Supervisor and Region Superintendent recommendation.
- Completion of Assistant Principal Induction Program (APIP).
- Successful application and screening process.
