


2024-2025 HR STEM Fair Grades 6-12 Timeline & Dates for Teachers/Adult Sponsors



The Hillsborough Regional STEM Fair is held to the rules and guidelines of the <u>ISEF</u> and FFFS which sponsors the <u>SSEF</u>. Students and their supporting adults can refer to these websites for all guidelines.

Hillsborough Regional Schools should host their own Science & Engineering Fair prior to December so that the highest quality projects can be identified and entered into the HR STEM Fair competition.
