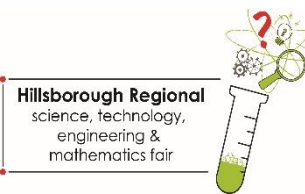


2024-2025 HR STEM Fair Grades 6-12 Timeline & Dates for Teachers/Adult Sponsors



The Hillsborough Regional STEM Fair is held to the rules and guidelines of the [ISEF](#) and FFFS which sponsors the [SSEF](#). Students and their supporting adults can refer to these websites for all guidelines.

Hillsborough Regional Schools should host their own Science & Engineering Fair prior to December so that the highest quality projects can be identified and entered into the HR STEM Fair competition.

Sept 9 th and/or Sept 16 th	<p>Training for Adult Sponsors & the school STEM Fair Contacts – @ Nature’s Classroom with Karen Johnson & Dianne Schroeder. This prepares STEM Fair Contacts & Adult Sponsors to appropriately screen a project and to guide students through the process of preparing the students for competition. August- September	Students Identify a Topic and Develop a Research Plan for the Scientific Investigation	Templates for student Research Plan are located on Google Site
	<p>For projects needing prior-SRC approval, email Karen Johnson to obtain permission for students to begin the investigation outlined in their Research Plans.</p> <p>Projects needing prior-SRC approval include: Vertebrate Animal studies, PHBAs, Hazardous Chemicals Activities & Devices. Although Human Subject studies are to be approved by the school level-IRB, it is highly recommended that they also receive prior-SRC approval before experimentation begins.</p> <p>Experimentation can commence only AFTER all appropriate approvals are obtained and the student has completed a detailed research plan.</p>	SRC Approval can be requested by emailing Karen.Johnson@hcps.net or by submitting a request via this SRC Prior Approval Form on the Google Site

Private and charter schools will be responsible for additional costs for any 6-12 students advancing to State and International Fairs. 	Invoice

Tuesday, February 11, 2025	<p>Project Set-up 3PM to 7PM.</p> <p>Students who take advantage of early bird set up will have their project boards screened for physical features and will not have to arrive at Tampa Convention Center until 11:00am on Wednesday, 2/12</p>	
Wednesday, February 12, 2025	<p>Judging Day</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Project Boards set up and screening for physical features 8:30-10:30am • Students must remain at their project for judging 11:45-4:00pm • Students may be released prior to 4pm - once all projects in their category have been judged <p>Students should have their <i>original</i> paperwork on hand at the Tampa Convention Center.</p>	Original paperwork
Wednesday, February 26, 2025	<p>Awards Ceremony Broadcast</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Categorical and Special Awards announced <p>Students who qualify as state finalists "Team Hillsborough" will be contacted prior to the award ceremony so that State finalist materials can be submitted by the due date (Team Hillsborough will compete at the Florida State Science & Engineering Fair (SSEF) in April)</p>
