 also have an opportunity to earn an Industry Certification. These courses will have (CTE) at the end of the course name to help
 guide you.
- AP Human Geography, AICE Thinking Skills, and AICE General Paper are also found in this category.
- All Foreign Languages are found here too. It is strongly suggested to take 2 years of the same foreign language.

Category 2: Semester Electives

- Students who select electives from this category will need to select 2 to create a full year's worth of electives.
- All 9th graders will need to select at least 1 from this category to compliment the required half-year American Government course.
