DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS: To earn the Cambridge AICE Diploma, learners must achieve a minimum of seven credits (including Cambridge International AS Level Global Perspectives & Research) from subject groups 1, 2, and 3 (and optionally Group 4). At least one credit must come from each of Groups 1, 2 and 3. The remaining credits can come from any of the groups. A maximum of two credits can count from Group 4. A student is awarded credit by successfully passing the Cambridge International Exam with a score of an a-e.

Reminders for AICE Diploma Candidates. Parents please take time to review this document with your student.

- I understand that to earn the AICE Diploma I must study and pass a total of 7 exams, including AS Level Global Perspectives and Research, and at least one from each of Groups 1, 2, and 3.
- I understand that Group 4 is optional, but I can earn at least 2 points toward my AICE Diploma in this group.
- I understand that I have 25 months (about 2 years) from my first exam to earn all 7 points for the AICE Diploma, with the time beginning when I sit for my first exam.
- I understand that I must complete a Cambridge Transcript Request for my scores to be sent to the university or college of my choice.

- I understand that if I earn the AICE Diploma, and have 100 community service/work hours, I am eligible to receive the Academic Scholars Award for the Bright Futures Scholarship.

- I understand that if I am reliant on the AICE Diploma (ADIP) for Bright Futures, it will not show up until the release of the August of my first college year, even if I qualified for the ADIP in 11th grade. Sumner will submit my eligibility to Cambridge and Bright Futures will confirm them for all graduated seniors in August when the June 2024 scores are released.
