Students will:

- Be aware of and follow all of the camp rules, routines, and procedures.
- Be aware of and follow all of the transportation rules, routines, and procedures on the field trip.
- Arrive on time every day of the camp prepared to participate and learn.
- Follow the normal school district dress code.
- Actively contribute to a positive, safe, and cooperative environment.

Parents/Guardians and family members will:

- Be aware of and follow all of the camp rules, routines, and procedures.
- Arrive on time every day for both drop-off and pick-up of the camp. (Within 15 minutes of scheduled times)
- Ensure students follow the dress code.
- Communicate with all camp personnel in a civil manner.
- Provide accurate and up-to-date contact information.
- Contribute to a positive, safe and cooperative camp environment.
- Understand and follow the camp discipline plan.

Camp Rules

- Students must keep their hands, feet and other objects to themselves.
- No unkind words (No bullying, no racial comments, or inappropriate words.)
- Students must stay in their assigned seat/area.
- Students must always follow instructors' directions. (No arguing)
- Students must not yell, talk across the room, or interrupt instruction.
- No food or drink is allowed in any room other than the cafeteria.

CAMP DISCIPLINE PLAN:

1. First violation – verbal warning by camp staff
2. Second violation – student time-out and written warning by staff to parent at pick-up
3. Third violation – Parent pick-up immediately and student can return following day.
4. Forth violation – Student must be picked-up immediately and cannot return, no refund will be given.

All the above must be honored for the duration of the camp. Failure to comply will result in the student's dismissal without a refund. Working together means we will all have a fun, safe and successful camp.
