Environmental clean-up projects	Helping your parents or other family members if they are involved in a charity or community service project
Making Strides Against Breast Cancer Walk	Tutoring a family friend or neighbor WITHOUT accepting money
Veterans' Day initiatives	Babysitting or working for free in a nursery at a church, mosque, synagogue, or temple
Earth Day projects or beautification	Volunteering in a hospital, daycare, assisted living facility, or animal shelter WITHOUT accepting money
CEO – Service and action options	Serving others at a shelter, food pantry, or soup kitchen

If you have other service learning activities or projects you are interested in doing, please check with a teacher or administrator to see if they qualify as service learning options.

Other consideration about service and action activities/projects:

- Activities/projects should be non-competitive.
- You must fill out all parts of your service and action booklet.
- You should choose activities/projects that are meaningful to you and that you will be able to complete successfully.
