Hawk Nation:

As a school, we were just recognized for increasing our acceleration success by 36% over the last 5 years. Florida has placed this into our school grade. Acceleration points mean that graduating seniors have either passed an AP exam, an AICE exam, passed a dual enrollment course, or earned an industry certification through our Career and Tech Electives. In 2019, our graduation rate was 80% and our acceleration rate was 41%. The class of 2024 has a graduation rate of 86% and the acceleration rate is now at 77%. The bar for graduation also rose in 2023 for students to reach their reading and math benchmarks. This is a true testament to HawkNation continuing to rise to amazing heights.

We also hosted a Girls Summit on Thursday, February 13th. We had girls from a variety of grade levels work on vision boards and had amazing community leaders speak with them. It was an amazing event!
